ASTRONAUT TRAINING DURING SUMMER BREAK

Astronaut training was held from May 14th to May 25th 2018. It was conducted by Matt Harasymczuk, Astronaut Trainer, Aerospace Engineer and Researcher, European Space Agency and Dr Agata Kołodziejczyk, Advance Concepts Team, European Space Agency. It was attended largely by students of S4 and S5. The programme included an exclusive insight, introduction and detailed knowledge required to become an astronaut right from the selection process to the training process. The participants learnt about the cutting-edge technologies and design humanity's first human habitats to colonize mars. Designs included living and research quarters on Martial surface. They learnt about the Mars Mission parameters, tasks and problems and device solutions and space technologies. Participants also learnt the elements of rocket booster and space shuttle design. After learning the basics, the students designed India's space shuttle for human mission to outer space.

Apart from the astronaut training workshops of one hour duration were held on various aspects like Apollo 11- NASA Mission to Moon, which was a shuttle simulator. It simulated the launch, space entry, space docking, journey to moon, landing on moon and reentry to earth. Another simulation was that of the Everest Expedition. It covered the climb, Summit, ascent and descent. Drone flying covered Drone manoeuver, drone control, flight control and racing. The Google Arts and design Modules enabled the students to paint, design and draw in 3 D form.
