As a part of the Environment Day celebrations, a team of teachers and four students visited an exhibition at the India Gate lawns organised by the Government of India on the theme BEAT PLASTIC POLLUTION which showcased exhibits by innovators and scientists from far and wide.

The students were awestruck with innovations like furniture made of recycled plastic straws and bamboo shafts, coir mats for growing plants and vending machines that exchanged plastics for coupons of famous eating joints in Delhi.

The principle behind this innovative technique is that the water from the pots will slowly diffuse out and will water the plants at a regular pace over a period of time.
