

Modern School student creates an app that will cure backaches



Harsh Gupta of S7-C has launched a smart phone app that can help back-pain sufferers track and control their condition. After months of suffering from acute upper back illness due to excess smart phone usage, the 17-year old designed and developed 'Spined', an Android application that detects bad posture. The app then issues warnings to coax users into

switching to a back-healthy posture. Dainik Jagran covered Harsh's innovation on the front page of Sunday's edition. Mid-Day has also written a detailed article on Spined application. Harsh's research paper titled 'Smartphone Based Cervical Spine Prevention' has been published in the February edition of International *Journal of Software Engineering and Applications* (JSEA). He has also filed an Indian Patent for the same, which is expected to be granted in a couple of months. The android app was **#1 Trending in Health and Fitness** on Google Play Store for two days after the release. It has fetched more than 2000 downloads and 50 reviews with 3.2 rating currently. Harsh is still crafting the app to perfection so that everyone can lead a posture-healthy life!
