

DESIGN FESTIVAL AT DOON SCHOOL

Doon School Dehradun organised a Design Festival from 12th to 14th November 2018. Modern School was privileged to be a part of this learning experience. Four students from our school, including Varun Malhotra (S6E), Tanvi Jitani (S6H), Aishwarya Aggarwal (S5B), and Tvesa Tandon (S5B) attended this threeday workshop. The highlights of this workshop included the craft of Kutch (leather craft) and metal casting technique of West Bengal (dhokra). The no-sew garment making technique- Button Masala taught by NID alumni Mr Anuj Sharma was another

On the first day, the craft person demonstrated how to puncture parched leather to create different items like key chain, mobile holder, coin purse and bookmark. The second day was yet another enthralling experience where students had a hands-on experience with the Dhokra Art done with bee wax coated with black molten wires and cast in metal. The third day was presided over by the noted designer Anuj Sharma who taught how to make no-sew garments using buttons. It very interesting and informative workshop held in the sylvan picturesque environs of the Doon School which inspired the students to think aesthetically and design in innovative manner.
