EDUCATION WORLD AWARD 2019

Modern School Barakhamba Road was ranked first by the EducationWorld as the top day-cum-boarding school in India for the year 2019-20 under the tutelage of the principal Dr Vijay Datta. The Education World India School Rankings (EWISR) 2019-20 is the world's largest and most indepth school ratings and rankings survey, based on field interviews with over 12,000 knowledgeable stakeholders in the school education countrywide. The EWISR considers fourteen parameters including cocurricular education, infrastructure provision, internationalism, competence of faculty, leadership, community service, among determining parameters indicating the blazing path that students and faculty of Modern School have forged in its endeavour for excellence.



Swimming helps us relax and rejuvenate. At Modern School we encourage our students to participate in sports and indeed they have made us proud time and again. The IPSC Swimming Championship was held at Raipur from 30th September to 5th October 2019, A total of 28 teams participated in the

championship.

Modern School Barakhamba Road won a total haul of 39 medals-11 Gold .12 Silver and 15 Bronze.

- Yashwani Suhag (S6J) was declared the Best Swimmer of the meet with 5 Gold in the Under-19 Girls' Category.
- Aditya Kumar (S4H) was declared the Best Swimmer of the meet with 4 Golds and 1 Silver in the Under-19 category.

- Boys' Under-19 team from Modern School was declared the Runner up of the Championship.
