THE NDMC ANNUAL SCIENCE FAIR 2019-20

The NDMC Annual Science Fair 2019-20 was held from 4th to 7th December at Atal Adarsh Prathamik Vidyalaya, Lodhi Road. Modern School Barakhamba Road, participated in the event and designed two projects for the Fair. Sharanya Gupta and Adrish Srivastava (S6-C) with their project Lake Action Plan (LAP) bagged the First Position in the sustainable development category. They proposed the idea for an economically viable version of a machine that can clear the surface of the lake with floating trash. The collected trash would then be recycled and used. Ira Aggarwal and Maira Aggarwal (S4-A) conceptualised and presented the project- "Reusing Milk- An Opportunity."

Modern School bagged the Fourth Position in the event.

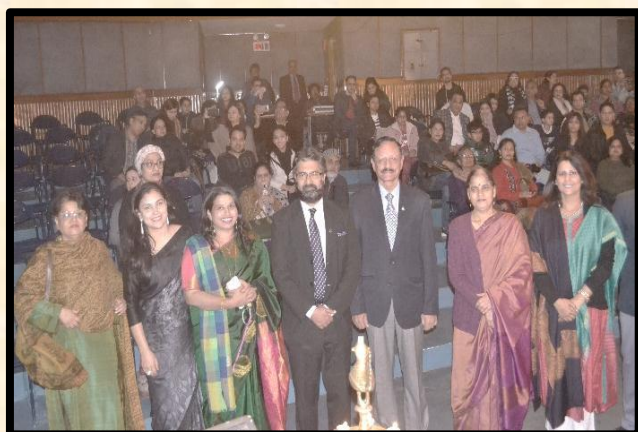
