The Students' Union of the All Indian Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) organized an exhibition 'Catalyst' on 27th and 28th April 2017 at the institute. hundred and five students from Modern School Barakhamba Road, of



classes S5, S6 and S7 witnessed the exhibition. The students got an opportunity to examine real human body organs and also to compare them with pathologically diseased organs.

Students were demonstrated the method to give CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation), which is an emergency procedure performed to restore spontaneous blood circulation and breathing in a person in cardiac arrest. The exhibition provided students with a chance to understand human anatomy beyond their textbooks and laboratory experience at school.
