The seventh edition of the Modern School International Model UN Conference was held from the 6th to the 8th of October 2017. The opening ceremony in Sir Shankar Lal Hall was presided over by the Chief Guest Mrs Navika Kumar Managing Editor Times Now and the Guest of Honour Mr Rajiv Chandra. In her speech Mrs Kumar not only expressed her hope for the success of the conference but also spoke about role of the young generation in ushering in a new era of globalism and international cooperation. This was followed by a stirring address by Principal Dr Vijay Datta and the official inauguration of the conference by the President of the MUN Society. ModMUN 2017 saw participation of over 760 delegates and teachers from more than 36 schools from all over Delhi and NCR.
