➢ On Green Initiative

On 20th November, Farhan Ahmed, Pradyumn Arora, Zaina Sharma, Anirudh Jain and Ayan Mehra of class S3 visited the WWF Office at New Delhi to attend a 'Go Green' workshop on 'Green' career opportunities. The Guest of Honour was Ms Megha Aggarwal, author of the book, 'The Green Guide to Environment Courses and Careers'.

The event began with a short explanation on 'Carbon-Footprint Reduction'. The guest then proceeded to inform about the 'Green' possibilities hidden in every career. She gave a diverse scenario on which she herself has worked on, such as the problem concerning elephant migration in India. In an interesting activity, the children were mixed and divided into groups of four. A fake judicial court was set up, with a jury, and each group was given a topic to defend or to challenge. Pradyumn Arora and Farhan Ahmed were adjudged Best Speaker and Best Defender respectively. Anirudh Jain and Ayan Mehra won a prize for the Best Jury.

These plants were placed in all classrooms, staffrooms and the Principal's office to provide fresh air to everyone.
