SCHOOL DETAILS

Year of Establishment - 1920

Modern School at Barakhamba Road is a co educational high school and is one of the premier and foremost public schools of the country.

A product of the founder's vision, the school is secular in nature and believes in imparting education free from all reservations and prejudices. The student body is culturally Indian. It is part residential thus extending opportunities to outstation students as well. The hostel is only available for boys. Modern School Barakhamba Road enrolls 2500 students in grades VI - XII with a graduating class of 395. The teacher-student ratio is 1:45.

SCHOOL CURRICULUM

The school academic year starts from April and closes in March. However, the grade X and XII graduate in April - May. As per the CBSE scheme of studies, the students take two years of the same subjects in the higher secondary i.e. Grade XI and XII. Each student is required to opt for one compulsory language at the core level along with four electives. The school offers these four subjects under three streams; Science, Commerce and Humanities.

EXAMINATION SPECIFICATIONS

The All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) is held from March to April for grade XII. It is a national level examination conducted at the same time in all CBSE schools of India. The school also conducts Mid-year Examination and Pre Board Examination to monitor the formative growth of the students.

GRADING SYSTEM

The scores are on a scale of 0-100 with a pass mark of 33%. The predicted grades are based on the super score/grade of each subject of the aggregate marks in grade XI and the performance in the Half Yearly Examination in grade XII with one upgradation in positional grade.

SCHOOL SUBJECTS

All courses bear the same level of difficulty. This means that the courses are not honors, accelerated etc. The courses studied bear the same rigor and are of equal weightage.

1. English: Compulsory for all.
2. Second language: The student can opt for a native or foreign language. Options are Hindi, Sanskrit, French, German and Spanish till X grade.
3. Mathematics with laboratory work
4. Science with Laboratory Practical - Physics, Chemistry, Biology.
5. Social Science - History, Geography, Economics and Political Science.
6. Along with these subjects the student take classes in ICT - Information communication and technology & Applications, Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW) and Physical and Health Education and receive a Co-Scholastic grade on it.

Modern School provides the children with the best sporting facilities. It is the only school to have an Olympic size pool as well as two grounds where games such as football, hockey etc. are initiated. Children who are a part of the school team and other interested students attend morning practice in school for extra training and fitness.
